



50/50 Raffle Process and Rules

- Starting October 1
- Cost is \$5 to play. If you put \$20 in the envelope, you are entered for 4 weeks (only \$5/week).
- 50/50 Raffle envelopes in the back of church must be used and must include your St Christopher envelope number
- Drop raffle envelope in collection basket during mass (or drop off in the parish office prior to 9:00 am on Monday.)
- Winning number will be drawn Monday afternoon or Tuesdays, if Monday is a holiday
- You can only win if you have played the week your number was drawn.





50/50 Raffle Process and Rules

Process / Rules:

1. Only parishioners with active church envelope numbers can play. If you don't know your church envelope number, please call Beth Crouch in the parish office.
2. A 50/50 envelope must be used. They can be found in the bulletin racks in the back of the Church. If a parishioner plays the 50/50 raffle with an inappropriate envelope (not the 50/50 envelopes), we cannot guarantee that the money will be received for the 50/50 raffle. All 50/50 envelopes will be kept to confirm who has played that week
3. Parishioners must **legibly** write their **church envelope number** and **name** on the outside of the envelope and include \$5. If less than \$5 is included in the envelope it will be considered an invalid entry and will not be eligible to win even if drawn. You can put enough money in an envelope to play for multiple weeks. For example, if you put \$10 in the envelope, you will be entered for 2 weeks, or \$40 and you are entered for 8 weeks, etc.
4. The 50/50 envelope with church envelope number, name and money should be dropped in the mass collection basket during mass or it can be dropped off at the parish office.
5. 50/50 envelopes must be received by 9:00 am Monday morning to be eligible for the drawing.
6. The drawing will take place either Monday afternoon or Tuesday morning, if Monday is a holiday.
7. A number will be drawn from all active church envelope numbers.
8. Only parishioners who have correctly played that week can win the raffle. If an envelope number is drawn of a parishioner who has not entered that week, the 50/50 fund will roll over to the next week.
9. If the church envelope number that is drawn matches a church envelope number entered that week, the parishioner with that church envelope number will receive 50% of the balance in the 50/50 fund.
10. The winning number will be displayed in each week's bulletin and notification if the 50/50 fund was won or rolled over to the next week.
11. When the 50/50 pot reaches \$9,000, we will draw a number until we have a winner that week.
