- 5.2.1 Jim McMechan
  - 5.2.1.1 As of 3/11/18, income is \$23,718 ahead of the same time last year. Approx +2.3%.
  - 5.2.1.2 Finance Committee will be holding its budget planning meeting next week.
  - 5.2.1.3 Potential impact to the budget will come from new Archdiocese requirement of <u>all</u> volunteers going through background checks. This could be cost-prohibitive for events such as festival. More information will be forthcoming from the Archdiocese.
  - 5.2.1.4 School Auction results are still being tallied. It went well, considering it was the first year under the new format. There were approximately 250 attendees.
