

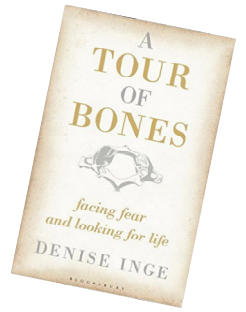
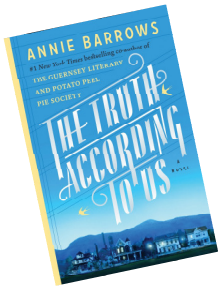
2017 EXPLORATIONS IN FAITH – A Book Club
